

Banwell Parish Council
Invitation to Tender – Supply of Recycled Plastic Fencing for Riverside Green

1. Requirement

Banwell Parish Council invites quotations for the supply and delivery of approximately 200 metres of recycled plastic knee-high boundary fencing for Riverside Green, Banwell. Installation will be arranged separately and does not form part of this tender. The Council is seeking a durable, low-maintenance fencing system suitable for a public green space.

2. Specification

The fencing should:

- be manufactured predominantly from recycled plastic;
- be approximately 600mm high;
- be suitable for permanent external use;
- have replaceable individual components;
- include all posts, rails, brackets and fixings required for installation.

Tenderers may propose different post-and-rail designs, provided the finished appearance is appropriate for a village green setting. The Council would particularly welcome discreet and visually suitable bracket/fixing arrangements. Please provide photographs or drawings of the proposed fencing and fixings.

3. Information Required

Tenderers should provide:

- full product specification;
- post and rail dimensions;
- proposed post spacing;
- anticipated service life;
- manufacturer warranty/guarantee;
- percentage recycled content;
- confirmation of whether the product can be recycled at end of life;
- any maintenance requirements;
- availability of replacement posts, rails and fixings;
- delivery lead time;
- total price excluding VAT;
- confirmation that all brackets, fixings and delivery are included.

Any exclusions should be clearly stated.

4. Pricing

Tenderers should provide a complete price for the supply and delivery of approximately 200 metres of fencing, including all posts, rails, brackets, fixings and other components necessary for installation.

Any exclusions must be clearly identified. Final quantities will be confirmed before an order is placed. Prices should remain valid for at least 90 days from the tender closing date.

5. Evaluation

Tenders will be assessed on overall value for money, including:

- price;
- durability and warranty;
- maintenance requirements;
- environmental characteristics;

- appearance and fixing design;
- availability of replacement components; and
- delivery timescale.

The Council is not obliged to accept the lowest-priced tender.
